- Facilitate Bible study and lead games and activities in small and large group settings.
- Responsible for some planning with cabin groups according to the daily program.
- This position spends each day surrounded by youth, faith, and the outdoors, providing a safe atmosphere where youth find unique opportunities to grow in faith and experience God's love through community and creation.
- Participate in daily and weekly staff meetings.
- Carry out established roles for supervising camper health and safety regulations.
- Maintain communications with all staff, and pass on to the Program Director any suggestions or comments concerning any/all aspects of the program.
- Follow the direction and supervision of the Program Director in all matters of program, personal behavior, and camper relations.
- Serve as a representative of GEV to pastors, youth directors, education directors, volunteers and parents.
- Perform other duties and assignments as requested.
